PROCUREMENT OF GOODS: RE BIDDING – LABORATORY REAGENTS AND SUPPLIES
FOR 2020 Category I.4: FULLY AUTOMATED CHEMILUMINESCENT PRINCIPLE WITH
PROVISION OF MACHINE (LOT BID)

WHEREAS, the San Lazaro Hospital, through its Bids and Awards Committee Two, posted an Invitation to Bid No. BAC2-2020-001: Procurement of Goods – Re Bidding Laboratory Reagents and Supplies on September 30, 2020 with fund source from GAA/Income 2020 at PhilGEPS website, SLH website and in other conspicuous places in the hospital;

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2020, the abovementioned item had their first bidding and was declared Bid Failure thru BAC Resolution # **PB-043 s. 2020 Bids and Awards Committee Three**;

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2020, only **Zafire Distributors, Inc.** attended the Pre-Bid Conference. Subsequently, the said bidder also procured the bidding documents;

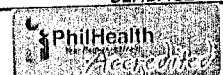
WHEREAS, on October 23, 2020, Notice of Post Qualification was sent to the Single Calculated Bidder;

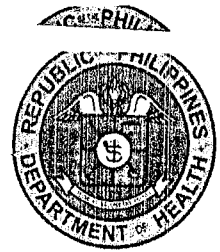

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2020, BAC2, together with the TWG and End User, deliberated on the findings and the offered bid of **Zafire Distributors, Inc.** for **Category I.4: FULLY AUTOMATED CHEMILUMINESCENT PRINCIPLE WITH PROVISION OF MACHINE (LOT BID)** was found to be responsive;

NOW THEREFORE, We, the members of the **Bids and Awards Committee Two**, hereby RESOLVE as it is RESOLVED:


1. To declare **Zafire Distributors, Inc.** as the **Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB)** for **Category I.4: FULLY AUTOMATED CHEMILUMINESCENT PRINCIPLE WITH PROVISION OF MACHINE (LOT BID)**;






2. To recommend the award of contract to **Zafire Distributors, Inc.** with a total contract price of **Three Million Six Hundred Thirty-five Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Six Pesos and 70/100 (PHP 3,635,466.70)**;
3. To submit this recommendation to the Medical Center Chief II for approval.


