PROCUREMENT OF GOODS: RE-BIDDING- Drugs and Medicines CY 2020
(Category III.1: Anti- Rabies Vaccine Injection: Verocell)

WHEREAS, the San Lazaro Hospital, through its Bids and Awards Committee Two, posted an Invitation to Bid No. BAC2-2020-001: Procurement of Goods – Drugs and Medicines on September 30, 2020 with fund source from GAA/INCOME 2020 at PhilGEPS website, SLH website and in other conspicuous places in the hospital;

WHEREAS, the abovementioned item has its first Public Bidding and was declared bid failure thru **BAC Resolution PB #004 s. 2020 dated March 4, 2020**;

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2020, the following bidder attended the Pre-Bid Conference. Subsequently, the following bidders also procured the bidding documents:

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2020, **Phil Pharmawealth, Inc.** and **Pharma- Surrey International Inc.** participated for the abovementioned category during the conducted Submission and Opening of Bids. The two bidders were asked if they are amenable of postponing the opening of bids on the following day, since, same item (Category VI.I) will also be opened. The two suppliers agreed and the Bids and Awards Committee took the custody of the submitted bidding documents;

1. To declare **Phil Pharmawealth, Inc.** as the **Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB)** for **Category III.1 : Anti- Rabies Vaccine Injection-Verocell ;**
2. To recommend the award of contract to **Phil Pharmawealth, Inc.** with a total contract price of **Six Million Four Hundred Seventy Three Thousand Seven Hundred Forty Pesos (PHP 6,473,740.00);**
3. To submit these recommendations to the Medical Center Chief II for approval.
